Tasting Notes:

Definitely a wine for the Rhone at heart, our 2006 Syrah is medium dark colored with captivating aromas of plums, jasmine, citrus blossoms, smoked meats and a mineral quality that lead to flavors of blueberries, dried raspberries, mulberries and hints of white pepper, earth and bacon fat. This wine is creamy and soft on the palate with an amazing layering of flavors and a long smooth finish.

Try this with roast meats, cheeses and pastas or just about anything off the grill.

This wine will age nicely for 6 to 10 years.
