Tasting Notes:

The 2006 Hayne Petite Sirah has a dark purplish black color with an intense nose of black cherry, coffee, mocha, smoked bacon, lavender and an intriguing hint of earthy mushroom and dried herbs. Bright cherry, raspberry and wild plum flavors lead to hints of dried orange peel, baking spice, pepper, chocolate and toffee. The wine has a lush mouthfeel with sleek balance of acidity, fruit and chewy tannins that lead to a long finish that seems to keep rolling over the palate.

Pair with lamb shank, wild game, veal, beef or strong cheeses.

Allow this wine plenty of air, it is drinking wonderfully right now but will continue to age well for the next 7 to 10 years.
