Tasting Notes:

The 2004 Hayne Petite Sirah is opaque purple in color with exotic aromas of coffee, deep black fruits, cured bacon and earth. On the palate, this meaty wine offers up flavors of ripe blackberries, kirsch, mocha, black currants and dried herbs. This wine is full-bodied and richly textured with a silky mouth feel, deep underlying tannins, and an amazingly long finish.

Pair with lamb shank, wild game, beef or strong cheeses.

This wine is drinking beautifully now, especially after allowing it plenty of air. It will age well for another 7 – 10 years.
