Tasting Notes:

The 2002 Morisoli Cabernet Sauvignon is inky purple in color with a blackberry, graphite, earth, spice and mineral-scented bouquet. These enticing aromas lead to dense flavors of black currants, wild plums, a hint of blueberry and creamy vanilla that build to a full-bodied layered finish. This wine is richly textured and seamless across the palate with gorgeous fruit, ripe tannins and nicely integrated acidity. The Morisoli Cabernet always has a sense of grace and elegance and this 2002 has quite a voluptuous finish. Wow! This may just be our best bottling yet.

Enjoy this wine with beef, game and ripe cheeses.

This beauty is drinking wonderfully now, though we do recommend decanting. Cellar some for drinking 12 – 15 years down the road; your patience will be rewarded.
