**Tasting Notes:**

The 2004 Morisoli Cabernet is opaque ruby-colored with a seductively aromatic nose of black truffle, cedar, cassis and mulberries with suggestions of mint, dusty earth and leather. On the palate, this full-bodied wine has deep focused flavors of black cherries, wild blackberries, dark plums, chocolate, mushrooms and hints of mineral followed by a generous mid-palate, silky tannins and a long smooth finish. The 2004 Morisoli Cabernet shows beautiful fruit ripeness, seamless texture, and well-integrated oak and tannin. True to form, it displays the power and elegance that is so characteristic of this vineyard. We honestly feel this might be the best one yet!

Enjoy this with rich meat dishes and cheese.

Drinking beautifully right now, this wine will age for at least 7 – 12 years.
