**Tasting Notes:**

The 2004 Morisoli Zinfandel has “wowed” us once again. The combination of the old vines, the field blend and the Rutherford Bench terroir creates a wine that is aromatically teasing and lush all the way across the palate. Aromas of sweet briary fruit lead to flavors of kirsch, cherries, raspberries and hints of white chocolate and toffee with an underlying mineral component. The wine is seamless on the palate with a lovely creamy texture and long pleasing finish.

Pair with rich tomato dishes, peppered steak, osso bucco or a selection of rich cheeses.

This elegant Zinfandel drinks beautifully now but ages gracefully. Cellar a few of these for drinking 5 – 10 years down the road. You won't be sorry.
