Tasting Notes:

The 2003 Morisoli Cabernet is a dark ruby colored with a seductively aromatic nose of cassis, mulberries, and blackberries with suggestions of graphite, vanilla, mint and lavender. On the palate, deep focused flavors of wild blackberries, kirsch, dark plums, white chocolate and hints of mineral are followed by silky tannins and a supple finish. Once again, the Morisoli Vineyard shows its characteristic power and elegance with complex layers of ripe, mature fruit flavors and hints of earth with graceful acidity and balance.

Enjoy this with rich meat dishes and cheese.

Drinking beautifully right now, this wine will age for at least 7 – 12 years.
