2009 L'INGENUE NAGGIAR VINEYARDS, SIERRA FOOTHILLS

This delightful wine is a blend of 36% Roussanne, 35% Viognier, 20% Marsanne and 9% Grenache Blanc. After about a year in French oak, the result is well-balanced, minerally, viscous with a lengthy finish and notes of fig, pear and peach.
